On June 10, 2025, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the Blount County Commission received an Application for Proposed Solid Waste Facility from Harvest Med Waste Disposal, LLC.

The process to approve or deny the Application shall include, but not be limited to the following events: application to the Blount Count County Commission, payment of an application fee to the Blount County Commission, notice to each owner whose property is adjacent to the proposed site sent by certified mail, publication of Notice of Application in the *Blount Countian* by the Blount County Commission, broadcasting public service announcements on local radio by the Blount County Commission, publishing notice on the Blount County Commission website, Public Awareness Sessions conducted by the Applicant, Harvest Med Waste Disposal, LLC., notice of the Public Awareness Sessions published in the *Blount Countian* by Harvest Med Waste Disposal, LLC., the review of the Application and recommendation of the Solid Waste Disposal Authority of Blount County, the conducting of a Public Hearing by the Blount County Commission, notice of the Public Hearing published in the *Blount Countian* by the Blount County Commission, a public vote at a public held meeting of the Blount County Commission either approving or denying the Application and review of said process by the Circuit Court of the 41st Judicial Circuit in a Declaratory Judgment Action filed by Harvest Med Waste Disposal, LLC.

In determining whether to approve or deny the Application, the Blount County Commission shall consider each of the following criteria: the consistency of the proposal with Blount County's solid waste management need as identified in its Solid Waste Management Plan; the relationship of the proposed location to local planned or existing development or the absence thereof, to major transportation arteries and to existing state primary and secondary roads; the location of the proposed facility in relationship to existing industries in the state that generate large volumes of solid waste, or the relationship to the areas projected for development of industries that will generate solid waste; the costs and availability of public services, facilities and improvements required to support the proposed facility and protect public health, safety, and the environment; the impact of the proposed facility on public safety and provisions made to minimize the impact on public health and safety; and the social and economic impacts of the proposed facility on the affected community, including changes in property values, and social or community perception.
